### **8<sup>th</sup> Physical Science**

### **10<sup>th</sup> Chemistry**

- Calculator TI30 at least. Your teen does NOT need a graphing calculator. Make sure it can perform scientific notation (exponent key) and logarithms (log key). These sell for around \$10.
- Home labs (per group): distilled water, white vinegar (16 oz), and head of red cabbage (may freeze for multiple uses).

### **Anatomy & Physiology**

-any system of your choosing for keeping notes (3 ring binder or spiral notebooks)

### **Algebra I, Algebra II, Advanced Math**

- Scientific calculator for Algebra 1 and Algebra II

-Advanced Math-TI 84 graphing calculator(Algebra 2 may use this as well if planning on taking advanced math)

-Algebra 2 students need nice metal compass and straightedge for quarter 4

-All classes need 2" binder with lots of paper, pencils and a colored pen and 1 pack of 1/4" graphing paper
