## **Science & Math Courses**

### **Physical Science**

- 3 ring binder or folder with prongs
- Loose leaf paper
- Pens and pencils
- Colored pencils
- Simple calculator

### **Biology**

- 1" 3 ring binder
- 10 dividers with tabs labeled as: Class info., Syllabi, Quizzes, Tests, Handouts, Projects, Dissections, Misc.
- Loose-leaf notebook paper
- Writing utensils

### **Chemistry**

-Calculator that can perform scientific notation and exponents. No need for a graphing calculator.

-For home labs, various household items: distilled water, white vinegar, baking soda, etc. Some items may need to be purchased at a home goods store, like denatured alcohol (ethanol.) Items need not be purchased in advance of the start of the school year.

-A binder with loose leaf paper for taking notes and for homework assignments.

### **Algebra I, Algebra II, Advanced Math**

- A TI84 graphing calculator will be used in all Algebra and Advanced Math classes

-Algebra 2 students need a metal compass and straightedge for quarter 4

-All classes need 2" binder with lots of paper, pencils and a colored pen and 1 pack of 1/4" graphing paper

### **Art**

Feel free to use anything you have.

Prismacolor Colored Pencil -12 pack (\$11.99)

Graphite Pencils (3) – H, HB, B

Small pack of paint brushes – varying sizes.

Eraser (Regular and or kneaded eraser)

Black Sharpie Marker (regular fine tip)

Masking Tape

Small bottle of Elmer's Glue

Scissors

Pencil Sharpener

Drawing pad 14" x 17" (Strathmore is a nice brand)

Small sketchbook (no specific requirements. I would try to pick something around 5" x 7" to 8.5" x 11". Something fun that your student will look forward to carrying around/doing a weekly sketch assignment in. Hobby Lobby and Michaels have lots of fun options.)

Drawing board – (\$20-25) A Masonite drawing board is an awesome tool. 24" x 36" is a great size, but you can use any lightweight wooden board that your student can carry to class. It should be big enough to tape a 14" x 17" piece of paper to, set on their lap and leaned against the table. Feel free to check out options at a hardware store, but you may need to sand the edges, a handle is not necessary.

Big Reusable shopping bag – These are \$1-2 at Marshalls/TJ Max/Home Goods or any easy to access bag that will hold art projects and tools (and maybe even that drawing board).

Pencil Bag – a small bag to hold pencils, eraser, sharpener, etc. isn't a bad idea. Whatever works!
